## HONOR AWARD CATEGORIES

**Distinguished Achievement:** Given to an individual AIA Blue Ridge member for special recognition of achievements and service to the profession. The award serves as an accolade for achievements throughout an entire career and therefore inspire younger professionals to serve in the lifelong commitment to architecture.

**Architectural Medal for Blue Ridge Chapter Service:** Given to a non-architect individual, project, or organization that has significantly improved the built environment of the AIA Blue Ridge region. It may also be bestowed upon an AIA Blue Ridge architect member whose influence goes far beyond standards of architectural practice. Who has demonstrated a commitment to their community by taking an active role in determining the policies and issues that shape the built environment.

**Blue Ridge Chapter Honor Award:** Given to an individual or organization who has contributed to the architectural profession through the professional and creative construction of artistic work within the built environment we use and experience everyday. It may also be bestowed upon an individual or organization who has inspired and directed the architectural profession through their efforts in an allied profession, research, planning legislative efforts, or architectural writings.

**Award for Preservation:** Given to an architect, owner, contractor, or organization contributing to the preservation or adaptive reuse of a significant structure, district, or site, or to the cause of preservation and adaptive reuse through education, research, or other endeavors.

## HONOR AWARD CATEGORIES (continued)

**Honorary Membership:** Given to an individual of esteemed character who is not eligible for membership in the AIA Blue Ridge but who has rendered distinguished service to the profession of architecture or to the allied arts and sciences within the domain of our Chapter.

**Test of Time Award:** This award is designed to recognize the lasting value of good architectural design and its value to the community. The facility must be no less than (25) twenty-five years old and must function in essentially the same manner for which it was originally designed.
